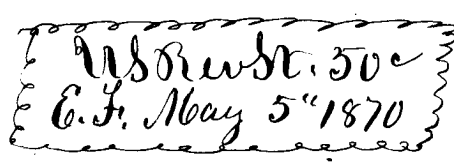

The undivided one third of the South half of Lots Seven and Eight (7 & 8) in Block Twenty one (21), and of Lot No One (1) in Block No Twenty seven (27) Original plat of Winterset, and Lots No Five and Six (5 & 6) in Block No Nine (9) in the West addition to

the City of Winterset, being my dower interest in and to the said described premises. — The further consideration of this conveyance is that the said J. W. Ford is to defray one half of the necessary expense, for my clothing and any incidental expenses, that may be necessary to my comfort and convenience.
