Thompson, Mary Ann Thompson of the County of Union, and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars, in hand paid, do hereby sell and convey unto Elisabeth Marrs of Union County, and State of Iowa, the following described Real Estate, situated in the County of Madison & Union and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The East half of the North East fourth of the North East quarter of Section Four (4) Town. Seventy-three (73) North of Range Twenty nine (29).—

And the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ in Section Twenty six (26), SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ in Section Twenty seven (27) in ———— Seventy four (74) N. of Range 29.

And the said Mary A. Thompson wife of the said John A. Thompson hereby relinquishes her right, interest or claim of dower in and to said land. — And the said grantors hereby covenant to Warrant and defend the title to the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
