To all to whom these presents shall come:
Greeting;

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Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," there has been deposited in the General Land Office, Warrant No 34,621 for 120 Acres, in favor of Asenath Eveleth widow of David Eveleth, Private Captain Frost's Company, Maine Militia, War 1812. — with evidence that the same has been duly located upon —

The West fractional half of the South West quarter, and the North East quarter of the South West quarter of Section Seven in Township Seventy four North, of Range Twenty seven West, in the District of lands subject to sale at Chariton Iowa, containing One hundred and Twenty nine Acres and Sixty five hundredths of an Acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General the said Warrant having been assigned by the said Asenath Eveleth to Elias B. Ogg in whose favor said tract has been located, and the certificate of said location having been assigned by the said Elias B. Ogg to Samuel Baker —

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Samuel Baker as assignee as aforesaid, and to his heirs the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Samuel Baker as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I James Buchanan President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the First day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine and of the Independence of the United State the Eighty third.
