

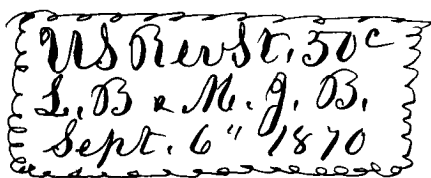

Brown hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises,
