Greeting:

Whereas, Nathaniel Clark of Madison County, Iowa, has, deposited in the office of the Register of the State Land Office, of the State of Iowa, a certificate of the Clerk of Dist. Court of Madison County, Iowa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Nathaniel Clark according to the provisions of the Act of the General Assembly, of the 25th of February, 1847, entitled "An act to provide for the management and disposition of the School Fund," for

The South East quarter of Section No Four (4) Township No Seventy four (74) North of Range No Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P. M. - Containing One hundred and Sixty Acres (160). -

According to the Official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned, to the General Land Office of the United States, by the Surveyor General; which said tract has been purchased by the said Nathaniel Clark. - - Now, know ye, that the State of Iowa, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of the General Assembly, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant unto the said Nathaniel Clark and to his heirs and assigns, the said tract of land above described;

To have and to hold the same together, with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Nathaniel Clark and to his heirs and assigns forever. - -

In testimony whereof, I, Samuel J. Kirkwood Governor of the State of Iowa, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of the State of Iowa to be hereunto affixed. -

Given under my hand at Des Moines, the Eighth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Sixty three, and of the State of Iowa the Seventeenth.
