Quit Cl. Deed
C. H. Blosser

Know all Men by these presents,

That we Jesse P. Pocock and Clarissa Pocock his wife of the County of Paulding and State of Ohio in consideration of the sum of One dollar to us in hand paid by Christian H. Blosser of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, and in consideration of the fact that on the 15th day of December 1863 we executed and delivered a Deed to John Haun for the consideration of Four hundred and fifty dollars for the following described Real Estate, situate in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The East half and the South West fourth of the South East quarter of Section (28) Twenty eight, in Township number (76) Seventy six North of Range N Twenty six (26) West, containing One hundred and twenty acres.

And whereas in said deed the name of the Grantee John Haun was by mistake written John Horn, and whereas the said John Haun has since deceased; and his widow and heirs have sold said lands to said Christian H. Blosser

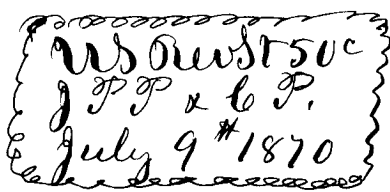
Now therefore to confirm and perfect the title of said Christian H. Blosser to said lands, in consideration of the premises aforesaid we do hereby remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said Christian H. Blosser his heirs and assigns the foregoing described premises, - To have and to hold the aforesaid premises with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, unto the said Christian H. Blosser his heirs and assigns forever; So that neither the undersigned nor our heirs, nor any person claiming under us or them, shall at any time hereafter, by any way or means have any claim or demand any right or title to the aforesaid premises or appurtenances, or any part or parcel thereof forever.

In witness whereof the said Jesse P. Pocock and Clarissa Pocock his wife who hereby relinquishes her dower in the said premises have hereunto set their hands and seals this 9th day of July 1870.
