That I, Robert Heath of Tippecanoe County, State of Indiana, in consideration of the sum of Six thousand and four hundred dollars in hand paid; do hereby sell and convey unto Margaret Dargan of Polk County, and State of Iowa, the following described premises, to-wit:

The North West quarter, and the North half of the South West quarter of Section Nine (9) and the East half of the North East quarter of Section Eight (8) Township Seventy seven (77) North of Range Twenty-six (26) West 5th P. M. Iowa.

And I do hereby covenant with the said Margaret Dargan that I am lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from incumbrance; that I have good right and lawful authority to sell the same; and I do hereby covenant to Warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
