The North half of South West fourth of Section Twenty six (26) Township Seventy five (75) North of Range Twenty nine (29) West, - And we do hereby covenant with the said parties above named in this deed, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said lands, that they are free from incumbrance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same, & we do hereby Warrant and defend the said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and the said Almira J. Weeks the lawful wife hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the above lands and subscribe our names this fourteenth day of November A.D. 1870,
