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To all to whom these presents shall come—Greeting;

Whereas C. D. Bevington of Madison County Iowa, has deposited in the office of the Register of the State Land Office, a Certificate of the Clerk of the District Court of Madison County Iowa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said C. D. Bevington according to law, for —

The North West quarter of Section No Sixteen (16) Township No Seventy six (76) North of Range No Twenty nine (29) West of the 5th P. M. — — Being a part of the 16th Section Grant, and containing One hundred & sixty Acres, according to the official plat of the survey of said Lands, which said tract has been purchased by the said C. D. Bevington.

Now know ye, that the State of Iowa, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of the General Assembly in such cases made and provided, Has Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said C. D. Bevington and to his heirs and assigns the said tract of land above described, to have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said C. D. Bevington and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, W. M. Stone Governor of the State of Iowa, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of the State of Iowa to be hereunto affixed. — Given under my hand at Des Moines the 23rd day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and sixty six, and of the State of Iowa the Twentieth.
