Commencing at the North East corner of the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section No One (1) in Township No Seventy five North of Range No Twenty-eight (28) West, running thence West Eleven Rods & fourteen &

one half links, thence South Twelve Rods & Twenty nine & one quarter links, thence East Eleven Rods & fourteen & one half links, thence North Twelve Rods & Twenty nine & one quarter links to the place of beginning. — And we do hereby Warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
