his wife of the County of Madison
And State of Iowa for the consideration of the sum
of four hundred Dollars, in hand paid do hereby sell
And convey unto William Anderson of the County
of Mahaska and State of Iowa the following described
Land, situated and lying in Madison And State
of Iowa, viz:

The West half of the North East quarter and the
North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section
fourteen (14) in township No Seventy four (74) of Range
No Twenty Six West, containing one hundred and
twenty acres more or less.

And we Warrant the Title to the same - to the said
William Anderson against all persons whomsoever -
