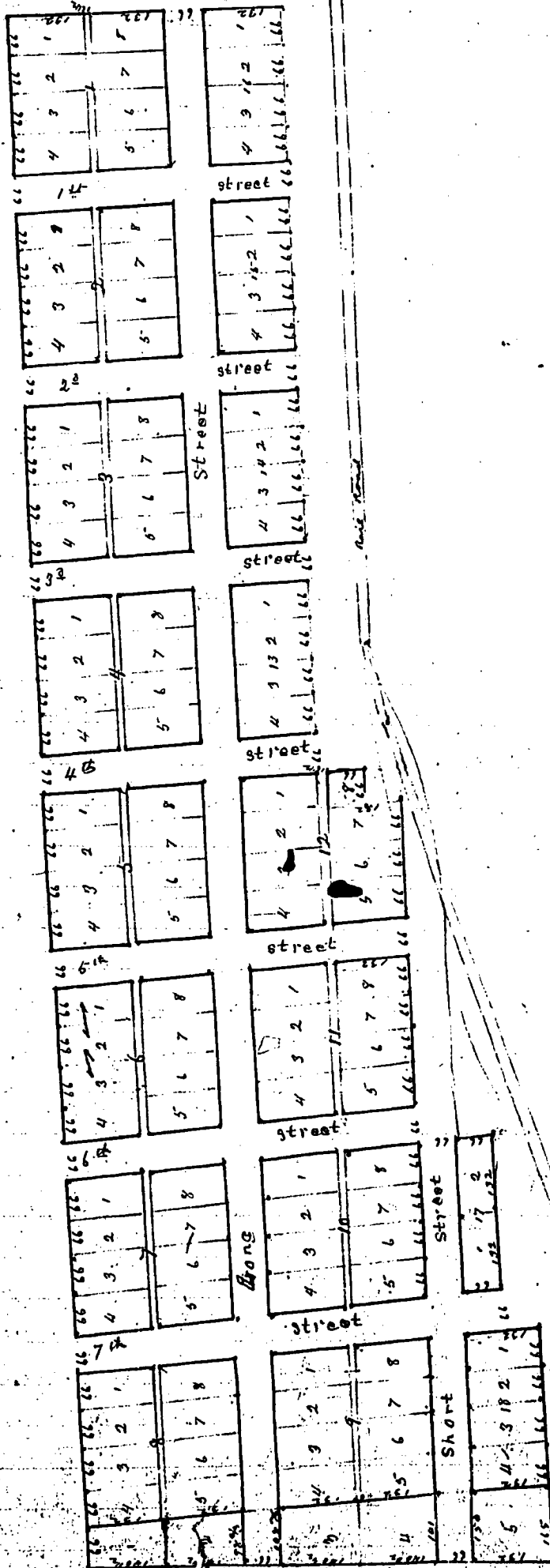


Don Plat of Patterson

Survey of the town of Patterson Madison County Iowa March 5th
 1872- Said town of Patterson is located on the South West quarter of
 Section No 29 in Tp 76 north of Ra 26 West of the 6th P.M. Iowa and
 more particularly described as follows to wit: Commencing at a point
 in the center of the west line of said quarter Section, being the west
 West corner of the South half of the South West Quarter of said
 Section 29, running thence East (at a variation of $16^{\circ}45'$)
 160 Rods to the East line of said Quarter Section; thence South
 (variation $16^{\circ}45'$) to 50 feet north of the center of the Des Moines
 Mutual and South Western Rail Road track; thence South West
 50 feet north and parallel with, said Rail Road to the west
 line of the aforesaid Quarter Section, thence north along
 the west line thereof to the place of beginning- Said town
 of Patterson is divided into ^{Eighty} Blocks and 5 out lots
 Blocks Nos. 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10-11 and 12 each have an alley
 $16\frac{1}{2}$ feet wide passing through the center thereof and are
 each divided into Eight lots; Each of the said Blocks,
 Except Block 12 is 264 feet wide East & West and $280\frac{3}{4}$ feet
 North and South, and each of the said lots except lot
 No 8 in Block No 12 is 132 feet north and South and 66
 feet East and West. Lot No 8 in Block No 12 is 66 feet square
 Blocks Nos 13-14-15-16 and 18 are each 264 feet East and
 West and 132 feet north and South and each are div-
 ided into four lots each of which said lots is 132 feet
 north and South and 66 feet East and West Block
 No 17 is divided into 2 lots each of which is 132 feet
 East and West and 66 feet north and South the Block
 being 264 feet East and West and 66 feet north and South
 Out lots No 1-2-3-and 4 is each $140\frac{1}{4}$ feet north and
 South, and lot 5 is 132 feet north and South and the
 length of the East and West lines of said Out lots is
 marked on, and shown by the said plat and all of the
 said lots and Blocks are ^{whichever of is} shown by the annexed plat
 which is a correct plat or map of said town. Each of
 the streets of said town is 66 feet wide, The streets running
 East and West are Long Street and Short Street
 & The streets running north and South are numbered
 commencing at the East end of the town 1st Street 2nd Street
 3rd Street 4th Street 5th Street 6th Street and 7th Street
 There is a stone firmly fixed in the ground at each

Some point in each street and there is a stake at each corner of each lot all of which is shown by the said plat. The said town was surveyed laid out and platted by me as above described the survey being made with a variation of $16^{\circ}45'$ East of north.
