 hereby sell and convey unto Ivin S. Ford, son of Madison County

 interest of my said wards Beekle B. Ford, Cora B. Ford, Malissa A.
 Ford and Emma A. Ford in and to Lots five (5) and Six (6) in Block

 Seven (7) and Eight (8), in Block Twenty-one (21) Original plat of ~~City~~
 Winterset and Lot one (1) in Block Twenty-seven (27) Original plat of
