 West half in N 1/2 & S 1/2 Section Nine (9) Township Seventy-
 four (74) Range twenty eight West

And we hereby covenant with the said George Fredrick-
 son that we hold said premises by good and perfect title
 that we have good right and lawful authority to sell
 and convey the same that they are free and clear of all
 incumbrances whatsoever and we covenant to warrant
 and defend the said premises against the lawful claims
 of all persons whomsoever and the said Georgia A. Thompson
 hereby Relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above
