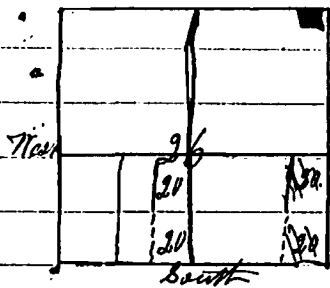


Know all Men By These Presents,

 do hereby quit claim to the said James Bell all our right
 title and interest in and to the following desc-
 ribed property in Madison County and State of
 Iowa, to-wit: The East half of the North East quar-
 ter of South West quarter of Section 26, Townsh-
 ip 76, Range 26, containing 20 acres.

And the said (Mary Jane Bell) relinquished all
 her right of dower in said premises, This deed is
 made to correct a deed made by Abner Bell Jr. &
 wife (dated January 6th 1859) to Allen Bell, recorded in
 Record H, Page 731, of Madison County Record, wherein
 said Bell signed his name as Abner Bell, instead of
 Abner Bell Jr. Signed this 18th day of November 1872,
