1873 2d. bl. Deed 1 Know All Men By These Presents:

D. H. Eyerly That Noah Sulgrove and Minerva

Sulgrove husband and wife of the county of Madison and State of Iowa, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, do hereby quit-claim unto Daniel H. Eyerly of Madison County and State of Iowa, all our right, title and interest in and to the following described land, situated and lying in Madison County and State of Iowa, to-wit:

Commencing Forty rods East of the South West corner of the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section Fifteen (15) Township Seventy six (76) Range Twenty eight (28), running thence North twenty rods, East Twenty rods South forty rods, West twenty rods (20), North Twenty rods to the place of beginning, containing five acres more or less.

This deed is made to correct a mistake in a deed to Burrell T. Noosley, dated Jan. 26th 1866, and Recorded in Book 2 Page 392 of Madison County Deed Records, and the said Minerva Sulgrove hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises,
