George Blosser Know All Men By These Presents:
 903 Right of Way Deed & That we George Blosser & Dorcas Blosser of
 D. No. M. & S. W. R. Co. Madison County, Iowa, for the consideration
 of four hundred Dollars to us in hand paid
 by the Des Moines, Winterset, and South Western Railroad Company
 a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Iowa, the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey
 unto the said Rail Road Company, the following piece or tract of
 land (Madison County in the State of Iowa, and particularly des-
 cribed as follows, to-wit: a strip of land through the South
 West quarter of Section Twenty Seven Township Seventy six (76) Range
 Twenty six (26) of said Rail Road locate a depot, on the premises of said Geo
 Blosser then the said Rail Road Company is to pay said Blosser nothing for
 for the right of way but if located on the premises of Geo Blosser the the company
 is to pay said Blosser one hundred Dollars, and if no depot is located
 at either place, then the said company is to pay said Blosser four
 hundred Dollars, One hundred feet in width being fifty feet on either
 side of the center line of the road of said Company, as located or to be located
 by the Engineer of the said Rail Road Company, for the construction of
 the said Rail Road from Des Moines, in Polk County, to Winterset, in
 Madison County, or from such point as may be hereafter designated,
 to have and to hold the same unto the said Rail Road Company forever
 Provided, that in case said Rail Road Company do not construct their
 road through said tract, or shall, after construction permanently
 abandon the route through said tract of land, the same shall revert to,
 and become the property of the grantor, his assigns and said company
 is to fence its right of way through said premises, and the said Dorcas Blosser
 hereby relinquishes her right of dower in the tract herein conveyed.
