Alexander Patterson Know All Men By These Presents:
For Right of way Deed That Alexander Patterson & Margaret A.
D. M. W. & S. W. R. R. Co. Patterson of Madison County Iowa, for the
consideration of One Dollar, to in hand paid by the Des Moines,
Winterset, And South Western Railroad Company, a corporation org-
anized under the laws of the State of Iowa, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey unto the Said
Railroad Company, the following piece or tract of land in
County in the state of Iowa, and particularly described
as follows, to-wit: a Strip of land through the South East quar-
ter of the South West quarter and the South West quarter of
the South West quarter of Section Twenty nine, Township
Seventy six, Range Twenty six, One hundred feet in width,
being fifty feet on either side of the center line of the road of said
Company, as located or to be located by the Engineer of the said
Railroad Company, for the construction of the said Rail Road from
Des Moines, in Polk County, to Winterset, in Madison County, or from
such point as may be hereafter designated, To Have and to
Hold the same unto the said Rail Road Company forever: Provi-
ded, that in case said Rail Road Company do not construct
their road through said tract, or shall, after construction,
permanently abandon the road through said tract of land,
the same shall revert to, and become the property of the grantor, or
assigns, and the said Margaret A. Patterson hereby relinquishes
her right of dower in the tract herein conveyed. Witness
