

1 | *Mary Dorrance, Administratrix,*  
 To *Z. Peck* Whereas at the County Court,  
*Isabella Kimmerer* within and for the County of  
 Madison and State of Iowa, on  
 the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October A.D. 1861, in a certain petition for  
 the sale of real estate wherein Mary Dorrance as Administratrix of Samuel Dorrance late of Madison County, Iowa,  
 deceased, was a petitioner, the said Mary Dorrance as  
 Administratrix obtained an order to sell certain real  
 estate of said intestate described as follows, to-wit:  
 The undivided half (½) of the North East fourth (¼) of the  
 South West fourth (⅛) of Section number Twenty Two (22)  
 in Township number Seventy five (75) North, and Range  
 number Twenty six (26) West in Madison County Iowa,  
 And whereas the said Administratrix having duly  
 advertised said real estate, did on the seventh day  
 of October A.D. 1861, sell the same to Isabella Kimmerer  
 of Warren County Iowa, for the sum of One  
 hundred and Forty dollars which sale was on the  
 day above named confirmed by the said County  
 Court, and the said Administratrix ordered to execute and  
 deliver a deed in fee simple to the said Isabella Kimmerer  
 for the said premises, all which will more fully  
 appear reference being had to the records of said Court.  
 Now therefore I, the said Mary Dorrance as Administratrix  
 of the said Samuel Dorrance in consider-  
 ation of the sum of One Hundred and forty Dollars  
 and by virtue of the power in me vested by law,  
 do by these presents sell and convey to the said Isabella  
 Kimmerer, the premises so sold to her as afores-  
 aid and as such Administratrix agree to warrant and defend  
 the title to the same against the lawful claims of  
 all persons whomsoever in ~~the~~ testimony whereof  
 I, the said Administratrix of the said Samuel Dorrance do  
 hereby unto set my hand this 1<sup>st</sup> day of Septem-  
 ber A.D. 1863,
