This Indenture, made the 29th day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and Sixty nine, between Matthew Bray and Maleny M. Bray his wife of in the County of Labette and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Samuel Doty of in the County of Madison, and State of Iowa, of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and fifty dollars, to them duly paid, have sold, and by these presents do remise, release, and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all estate, title, interests and claim, in and to that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa, and described as follows, to-wit:

The South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section No thirty five (35) in Township Seventy four (74) North of Range twenty nine (29) West, containing Forty acres, more or less with the appurtenances, to have and to hold the same unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
