consideration of the sum of One Hundred And fifty dollars, to  
them duly paid, have sold, and by these presents do remise, release,  
and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs  
and assigns forever, all estate, title, interests and claim, in and  
to that tract of land situated in the County  
of Madison and State of Iowa, and described as follows, to-wit:

The South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of  
Section No thirty five (35) in Township Seventy four (74) North  
of Range Twenty nine (29) West, containing Forty acres more  
or less with the appurtenances, to have and to hold the same
