Bridget Swift of the county of Madison and State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid do hereby Quit Claim unto Michael Donahue of Madison County and State of Iowa all our right title and interest in and to the following described land Situate and lying in Madison County and State of Iowa to wit: The west half of fourteen Acres on the the South side of the ^{South} east quarter of the North West quarter the West half of the North East quarter of the South West quarter and the East half of the South East quarter of the South West quarter all in Section No Eleven (11) in Township No Seventy Six (76) Range No Twenty Six (26) containing in all Forty Seven (47) Acres more or less This deed is made for the purpose of Subdividing the E 1/4 S W 1/4 Sec (11) and also the first above described fourteen Acres. And the said Bridget Swift hereby relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above described premises
