I, now all men by this Presents
Israel Miller & Malinda Dowers (widow) of Dowers & Mary
Dowers his wife James Dowers (unmarried)
John Heath & Elizabeth Heath his wife ^{Peter & Agnes Dowers his wife} heirs at law of Henry
Dowers deceased of the County of Cass and State of Nebraska in con-
sideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid do hereby give
claim unto Israel Miller of Madison County & State of Iowa all our
right title and interest in and to the following described land situated
and lying in Madison County and State of Iowa to wit:
commencing at the North East corner of Section Fifteen (15) Township
Seventy-Six (76) Range Twenty-eight (28) running thence West fifty
Four (54) rods thence South One hundred & four (1104) rods
to tract W corner of land of James truce East Fifty
four (54) rods truce North One hundred and Four (104) rods
to the place beginning containing Ninety Five (95) acres
more or less. This deed is made to supply a deed heretofore made
of Henry Dowers, but was lost and never recorded. John Heath
and the said Malinda Dowers, Mary Dowers & Henry Dowers
with their right of dower in and to the above described premises.
