Know all men by these presents
 That whereas the following de-
 scribed real property being lot No
 Six (6) in Block No Twenty-Two (22) of the Original
 Plat of the City of Winterset situated in the County of
 Madison and State of Iowa was subject to taxation for the
 years A.D. 1869, 1870, 1871, 1872, 1873, & 1874 and whereas the taxes
 assessed upon said real property for the years aforesaid
 remained due and unpaid at the date of the sale hereinafter
 named; and whereas the Treasurer of the said County sold
 on the 6th day of November 1875 by virtue of the authority
 given him vested by law at the Regular Tax Sale begun
 and publicly held on the first Monday of November
 A.D. 1875, exposed to public sale at the Treasurer's Office
 in the County aforesaid in substantial conformity with
 all the regulations of the Statute, in such case made and
 provided the real property above described for the
 payment of the taxes interest and costs then due and
 remaining unpaid on said property, and whereas at
 the time and place aforesaid C. O' McLaughlin of the
 County of Madison and State of Iowa having offered
 to pay the sum of Ninety-one dollars and four cents
 being the whole amount of taxes interest and costs then
 due and remaining unpaid on said property, and whereas at
 lot No Six (6) in N^o Block No Twenty-Two (22) in the
 Original Laramie plat of City of Winterset which was
 the least grantable and from payment of said sum having
 been by him made to the said Treasurer the said property
 was strucken off to him at price
 and whereas three years has elapsed since the date of said
 sale and the said property has not been redeemed therefrom
 as provided for by law, I am therefore by and in consideration
 of the sum sum to the Treasurer paid as aforesaid and by
 virtue of the Statute, in such case made and provided have
 granted bargained and by these presents do grant con-
 grant and sell unto the said C. O' McLaughlin his heirs
 and assigns the real property last hereinbefore described
 to him and to hold unto him the said C. O' McLaughlin
