Gulian's addition to the Town of Earlham Iowa And
I hereby covenant with the said John E Jones that I hold
said premises by good and sufficient title that I have good
right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same
that they are free and clear of all liens and incumbrances
whatsoever (Except Tax for the year 1872) And I covenant to
warrant and defend the said premises against the law-
ful claims of all persons whomsoever signed this 19th
day of 3rd month 1873
