ch 1873, make and assignment of all his property to John C. Jamison of said county, in trust for the benefit of the creditors of said Wm. L. Hamilton, to be administered in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio in such cases made and provided, and whereas the said Wm. L. Hamilton, and Rachel Hamilton, his wife, in furtherance of said trust, did on the 27th day of March 1873 execute and deliver to said John C. Jamison in trust as aforesaid a good and sufficient Warranty Deed for the hereinafter described premises and whereas the said John C. Jamison assignee as aforesaid, did, on the 26th day of April 1873, after given due notice by advertisement in the Cadiz Republican a weekly newspaper published and of general circulation in said county of Harrison, Ill., at public auction the said hereinafter described premises to Henry

G. Porter, for one Hundred and forty dollars, he being the highest and ^{best} order and that sum being more than two-thirds of the appraised value thereof, and said sale having been duly approved and confirmed by the Probate Court of said County, according to law the said John L. Jamison assignee as aforesaid was ordered to execute and deliver to said purchaser a proper deed for said premises according to the statutes in such cases made and provided. Now, therefore I, the said John L. Jamison as assignee as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of one hundred and forty dollars to me paid by said Henry G. Porter, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said Henry G. Porter the following described premises to-wit: The North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Thirty-two (32) Township Seventy-seven (77) N. Range 26, West, containing forty acres more or less, with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging. To have and to hold the same unto the said Henry G.
