 Range Number Twenty nine (29) containing Eighty ⁽⁸⁰⁾ acres
 more or less.

And we do hereby covenant with the said F. J. Fitt that we
 are lawfully seized of said premises, that they are free from
 incumbrances that we have good right and lawful authority
 to sell and convey the same, and we do hereby covenant
 to warrant and defend the said premises against the
 lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and the grantors
 of said hereby relinquishes all contingent rights, including
 right of dower which she has in and to the said described
