One Hundred and fifty Dollars, we William
Queen and Rachel Queen his wife do hereby
convey to James Queen the following Tract of land lying,

Section N^o Seven (7) in Township N^o Seventy five (75) North of
Range N^o Twenty six (26) West containing twenty eight acres
and 5/16th of an acre be the same more or less

And we hereby Warrant the title against all persons whom-
soever, In Witness Whereof, we William Queen and Rachel
Queen his wife have hereto signed our names, this Seventeenth
day of January Eighteen hundred and fifty four
