That we James Gillaspie and Ann  
Gillaspie husband and wife of  
the county of Madison and State of Iowa in consideration  
of the sum of Thirty Dollars, in hand paid, do hereby Quit  
Claim unto the District Township of Crawford of Madison  
County, and State of Iowa all our right, title and interest  
in and to the following described land, situated and lying in  
Madison County, and State of Iowa, to-wit:

One acre in a Square form in the North East corner of the  
South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section No.  
Fourteen (14) Township No. Seventy Six (76) Range Twenty  
Six (26) To have and to hold the same so long as the same  
is used for School purposes and when it is no longer  
used for school purposes then the same is to revert to  
the Grantor or his heirs or assigns.

And the said Ann Gillaspie hereby relinquishes  
her right of dower in and to the above described premises.
