Charles Blanton, This Indenture Made the ~~Twenty~~¹⁷ day of
March in the year of our Lord One Thousand
Eight hundred and fifty one Between Charles
Blanton of the County of Madison and State
of Iowa, of the first part Samuel Gipe of the County of Madison
and State of Iowa, of the second part Witnesseth that Said Charles Blan-
ton in consideration of the sum of One hundred and ten dollars
to him in hand paid by the Said Samuel Gipe the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and
confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and con-
firm unto the said party of the second part his heirs and ass-
igns forever, the following described tract or parcel of land
lying in the county of Madison and State Iowa, to wit:
North East quarter of North East quarter of Section No. forty-
four (44), in Township No. Seventy (70) N. of Range No. Twenty six
(26) W., containing forty acres, To have and to hold the
Said premises with all the appurtenances hereby sold and
conveyed unto the said Samuel Gipe his heirs and assigns
forever, and the said Charles Blanton himself his heirs
executors and administrators doth covenant with the

Said Samuel Dife his heirs executors administrators or assigns
that he the Charles Blanton is the lawful owner of said premises that
they are free from all incumbrances, and that he hath good right
and full power to convey the same in manner aforesaid. And
further that he will warrant and forever against all legal
claim or claims of any and all persons whomever.

nton his wife who hereby relinquishes all her right and title
to Dower in and to the above quarter and bargained premises
hath hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written

untary act and deed for the purpose therein mentioned and

and apart from her husband and the full contents and pur-
pose of the above deed being made known to her she acknow-
ledged that she signed sealed delivered the same and relinquished
her right and title to dower in the above premises of her own
free will and accord and at her act and deed without any
coercion or compulsion from her husband,
