following tract of land, to-wit:

East half of the South East quarter Section twenty one
Township No. Seventy Six, Range 27, Eighty acres more or less
And we covenant with the said John D. Brassfield and John Ham-
ilton that said premises are free from all liens and incum-
brances, and that we will warrant and defend the title
against all persons whomsoever.

And the said Norma Davis relinquishes all right or
claim of dower in and to said land.
