1873 Deed known All Men by These Presents;  
Mary E. Pixler That I J. B. Smith of the County of Hardin  
and State of Iowa, in consideration of the  
One Hundred Dollars, in hand paid by Mary E. Pixler of Madison  
County, and State of Iowa do hereby sell and convey unto the  
said Mary E. Pixler and to her heirs and assigns, the following  
described premises, to-wit: The North half (½) of the North East quarter  
(¼) of section No Three (3) in Township No. Seventy seven (7) North of Range No.  
Twenty eight (28) West of the 5<sup>th</sup> principal meridian Iowa, And I do hereby  
covenant with the said Mary E. Pixler that I am lawfully seized  
of said premises, that they are free from incumbrance, that I have good  
right and lawful authority to sell the same, and I do hereby covenant  
to warrant and defend said premises, and the appurtenances, against  
the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever; and Catherine Smith  
wife of J. B. Smith hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower in and to the foregoing  
premises, Signed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1872,
