 B. A. Gaskill That we William B. Newman and Eliza
 with J. Newman wife of Said William B.
 Newman of Boone County, State of Iowa, in consideration
 of the sum of Twenty five Dollars in hand paid, do hereby
 sell and convey unto B. A. Gaskill of Madison County ^{and}
 State of Iowa, the following described premises, situated in the Coun-
 ty, of Madison and State of Iowa, to-wit: A Strip of land 10
 feet wide and extending the whole length of the East side of the
 following described tract or parcel of land, commencing thirty-
 five Rods and twenty one and three quarter links West of the North East
 corner of the North East quarter of the North West quarter of section No
 one in Township Seventy five (75) North of Range No. Twenty eight
 West Running thence West thirteen Rods and seven and one
 quarter links thence South twelve Rods and twenty nine and
 one quarter links, thence East thirteen Rods and seven and one
 quarter links, thence North twelve Rods and twenty nine and
 one quarter links to the place of beginning. And we ^{do} hereby
 covenant with the said B. A. Gaskill that we are lawfully seized
 in fee simple, of the said premises, that they are free from incum-
 brance, that we have good right and lawful authority to sell
 the same, and we do hereby covenant to Warrant and Defend the
 said premises and appurtenances thereto belonging, against the
 lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, and the said Elizabeth J.
 Newman hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in and to the
