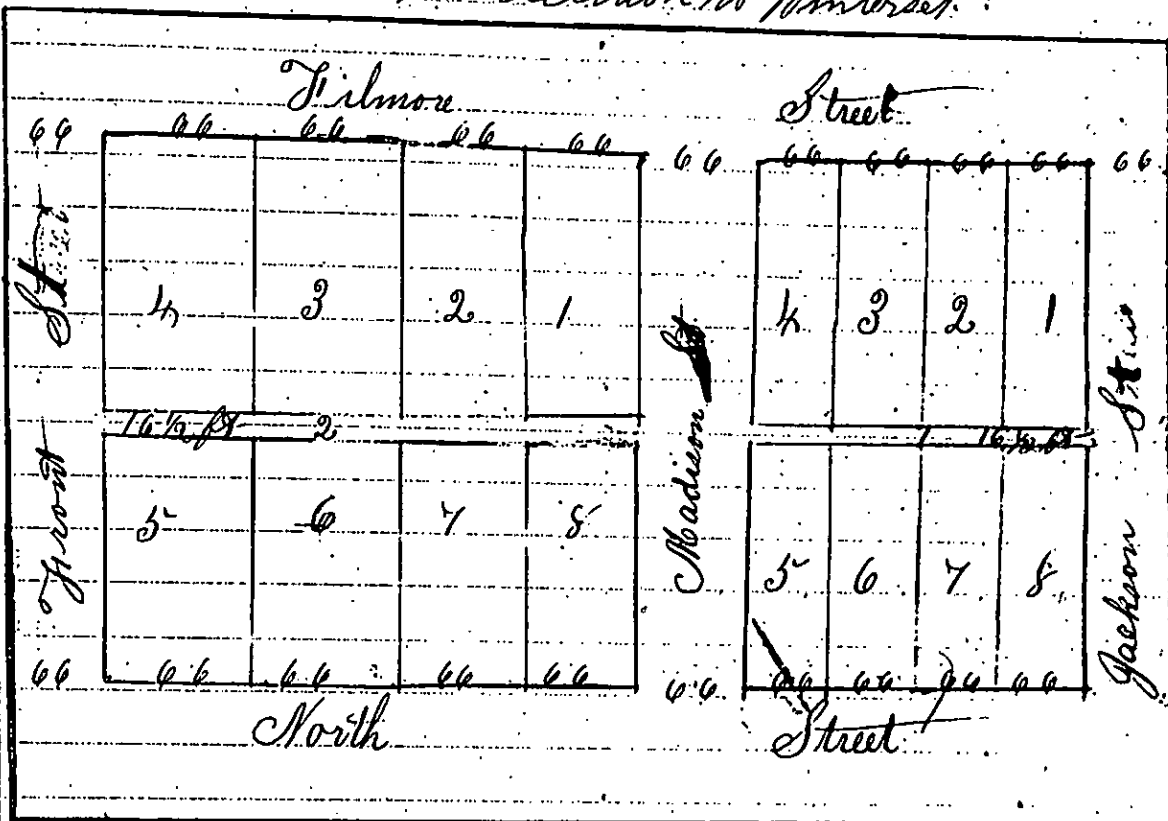

Center Addition to Winterset.



Survey of an addition to the Town of Winterset Iowa March 21st 1873. Said addition to be known as Center addition to Winterset Iowa, & the same is bounded as follows to-wit: commencing at Road East of the South West corner of the North West 1/4 of Section 31 of Twp 76, R. 27, running thence East 40 Rods, thence North 17 Rods, thence West 40 Rods, thence South 17 Rods to the place of beginning. Said addition is divided into two blocks, which are numbered as is shown by the above plat which is a correct map of said addition. Each of said blocks is 26 1/2 feet East and West and 280 1/2 feet North and South, and each of the said is divided into eight lots each of which said lots is 66 feet wide East and West and 133 feet long North and South and there is a stake driven in the ground at each corner of each lot. An alley 16 1/2 feet wide passes through each of said blocks running East and West. The streets running North & South are Front Street, Madison Street and Jackson Street, the streets running East and West are North Street and Gilmore Street. Each of which are 66 feet wide. The above named addition was surveyed, laid out and plotted by me on the said 21st day of March 1873, with a variation corresponding to the Original field notes for section and all of which is certified to be correct.
