Pollard of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, the following tract of land in Madison County Iowa,

The East half of the North West quarter and the South West quarter of the North West quarter of the North East quarter of Section Number Two, Township Number Seventy six, North of Range Twenty Seven West, of 5th P.M., Iowa.

And we covenant with the said Morgan S. Pollard that said premises are free from all liens and incumbrances, and that we will warrant and defend the title against all persons whomsoever.

And the said America McCaughan relinquishes all right or claim of dower in and to said land.
