 in hand paid, do hereby Joint-claim unto S. M. Dryerly of  
 Madison County and State of Iowa, all our right, title and  
 interest in and to the following described land, situated and  
 lying in Madison County and State of Iowa, to-wit:

The south West quarter of South West quarter, and the  
 south half of the North West quarter of the South West  
 quarter of section No Twenty two (22) - also twenty five acres  
 in the North West corner of the South East quarter of section  
 Thirty four (34) being One hundred rods North & South and forty  
 rods East & West, all in Township Seventy four (74) Range Twenty  
 six (26) - This Deed is made to correct a mistake in a Deed  
 dated Oct. 7, 1864, Recorded in book "B" page 99, wherein the name  
 is Samuel Early, And the Said M. J. Freeborn hereby  
 relinquishes her right of dower in and to the above de-  
 scribed premises,
