 To<sup>r</sup> 3 It, b.l. Deed That we William F. Swarfford, and  
 Israel Miller Matilda Swarfford husband and wife of  
 the County of Putnam and State of Indiana in consideration of  
 the sum of One Dollar & in hand paid, do hereby Quit-Claim unto  
 Israel Miller of Madison County, and State of Iowa, all our right,  
 title, and interest in and to the following described land, situated in  
 and in the following described land, situated and lying in Madison  
 County, and State of Iowa, to-wit: Commencing at the North  
 East corner of section fifteen (15) Township Seventy six (26) Range  
 Twenty eight (28), running thence West fifty four (54) rods, then  
 South One hundred & four (104) rods, to the N.W. corner of land of B.  
 James, thence East fifty four (54) rods, thence North One hundred  
 & four (104) rods, to the place of beginning, containing Thirty  
 five (35) acres more or less, This Deed is made to supply a deed  
 heretofore made, but was lost and never recorded. And the  
 said Matilda Swarfford hereby relinquishes her right of  
 dower in and to the above described premises,
