And we covenant with the said Mr. Acheson & John A.  
 Acheson that said premises are free from all liens and in-  
 encumbrances, and that we will warrant and defend the  
 title against all persons whomsoever,

And the said Rachel Garlinger relinquishes all right or  
 claim of dower in and to said land,
