Know All Men By These Presents
 That we J. S. McCaughan & America McCaughan of the County of Madison and State of Iowa for the consideration of \$4 Hundred Dollars, in hand paid, hereby convey to Woodard Work of the County of Madison and State of Iowa the following tract of land, to-wit:

Commencing at a point fifty feet North of the South West corner of the North half of the South West quarter of Section Twenty Six, Township Seventy Six, Range Twenty Seven - running thence North to the North West corner of said described Eighty acres; thence East to the North East corner of said described Eighty - thence South a distance of about three rods to the place where the East line of said described Eighty acres intersects a line running on the North Side of the Des Moines, Winterset and South Western Rail Road at a distance of fifty feet from the center of the track of said Rail Road; thence along said line at a distance of fifty feet from the center of the track of said Rail Road in a South Westly direction to the place of beginning, being all of the North half of the South West quarter of Sec 26, Twp. 76, R. 27, and the ^{North} Side of the said Rail Road, and we covenant with the said Woodard Work that said premises are free from all liens and incumbrances, and that we will warrant and defend the title against all persons whomsoever,

And the said America McCaughan relinquishes all right or claim of dower in and to said land, Signed and delivered this 4th day of October 1873.
