The West half of the South West quarter of Section No. Twenty
three (23) in Township No. Seventy Seven (77) North of Range
No. Twenty nine (29) West of the 1st P.M. Iowa, containing Eighty
acres (80) more or less, And all the Estate, Title and Inter-
est of the Said G. M. Lissom either in Law or Equity, of, in
and to the Said premises: Together with all the privileges and
appurtenances to the same belonging, and all the rents, issues
and profits thereof; To have and to hold the same
to the only proper use of the Said Daniel Hodge his heirs and
