 to the place of beginning, the said described land to be used
 for a Public Burial ground, And the said J. J. Greer hereby
 relinquishes all right, interest or claim of dower in and to the
 said land, and the said grantors hereby covenant to
 Warrant and Defend the title to the said premises against
 the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
