Know All Men by These Presents,  
That we, J. G. Evans and Emma Evans  
of Madison County State of Iowa in  
consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars in hand  
paid us by Sampson of Madison County State of Iowa,  
do hereby sell and convey unto the said G. E. Sampson the  
undivided one half of the following described premises situated  
in the County of Madison State of Iowa, to-wit:

Begins at a point in the middle River (being  
a part of the North West quarter of Section Six (6) Township  
Twenty five (25) North of Range Twenty nine (29) West) known  
as the South West corner of land owned Edward Lowden  
thence North thirty and  $\frac{1}{2}$  rods, thence West thirty eight rods  
to the center of the main channel of Middle River, thence down  
said main channel to the lower side of the mill dam, thence  
South to the south bank of Middle River sufficient to  
secure said dam thence North to center of the main channel  
thence down said main channel to place of beginning  
containing three and  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres more or less with the mill and  
all pertaining thereto, and we hereby covenant with the said  
Grantee that we hold said premises by good and perfect  
title, that we have good right and lawful authority to  
sell and convey the same that they are free and clear of all  
leis and incumbrances whatever and we covenant  
to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful  
claims of all persons whosoever, and the said Emma Evans here-  
by relinquishes her right of Dower in and to the above described  
premises, signed this 13<sup>th</sup> day of October 1873.
