Greeting,

Whereas, in pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th 1860 Entitled "An act granting Bounty Land To Certain Officers and Soldiers Who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States" Warrant No 129161 for 160 acres, issued in favor of Sophia, M. Brittain, widow of Philip Brittain, deceased Captain tenth Regiment United States Infantry Mar 1861 has been returned to the General Land Office, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North West Quarter of Section twenty nine in Township seventy five North of Range twenty seven West, in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Fairfield, Iowa containing One Hundred and Sixty Acres according to the Official plat of the Survey of the Said land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General which has been assigned to Mitchell Robinson Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said Mitchell Robinson and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony Whereof I Franklin Pierce President of the United States of America have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand at the City Of Washington, the ninth day of November in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three and of the Independence of the United States the Seventy eighth By the President.
