 O. H. Barker That we O. H. Barker and Lucy Barker (husband & wife) of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, for the consideration of Four Hundred and forty Dollars, in hand paid, hereby convey to E. G. Barker of the County of Madison and State of Iowa the following tract of land, to-wit:

The South East quarter (4) of the North East quarter (4) of section 18 (32) Thirty two, in Township 14 (75) Seventy five, Range 14 (29) Twenty nine in Madison County Iowa, containing (40) forty acres more or less, also commencing Thirty (30) rods South of the North East corner of the North East (4) quarter of the South East (4) quarter of section 18 (32) Thirty two, Township 14 (74) Seventy four North Range 14 (29) Twenty nine, West, and running thence South (6) Six Rods, thence West (80) Eighty Rods, thence thence North (6) Six Rods, thence East (80) Eighty Rods to the place of beginning containing (3) Three acres more or less.

And we covenant with the said E. G. Barker that said premises are free from all liens and incumbrances, and that we will warrant and defend the title against all persons whomsoever,

And the said Lucy Barker relinquishes all right or claim of dower in and to said land, Signed and delivered this 16th day of December 1873,
