Barker and his heirs and assigns forever, all our right title, interest, estate, claim and demand, both at law and in equity and as well in expectancy of, in and to the following described premises, to-wit: The South East  $\frac{1}{4}$  quarter of the North East  $\frac{1}{4}$  quarter of Section (9) Nine in Township N $2$ (74) Seventy-four, Range N $2$ (27) Twenty nine in the county of (Madison and State of Iowa, containing  $\frac{40}{100}$  forty acres more or less and the said Lucy Barker relinquishes ~~her~~ right of dower, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging,
