To All To Whom these Presents shall come
Greetings; Whereas W. B. West of Madison
County, Iowa, has deposited in the office
of the Register of the State Land Office, a certifi-
cate of the clerk of the District Court of Madison County, Iowa,
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the
said W. B. West according to law for the North West quar-
ter of the North West quarter of Section No. Three (3) Town-
ship No. Seventy four (74) North of Range No. Nine, eight
(28) West of the 5th P.M., being a part of the 5000 acres
Grant, and containing forty two and 8/10 acres, according to the
official plat of the Survey of said lands, which said tract
has been purchased by the said W. B. West.

Now, know ye, that the State of Iowa, in consideration
of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts
of the General Assembly in such cases made and provided,
has given and granted, and by these Presents do give and
grant unto the said W. B. West and to his heirs and assigns
the said tract of land above described, to have and to hold
the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities
and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto
belonging, unto the said W. B. West and to his heirs and
assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, W. M. Stone Governor of
the State of Iowa, have caused these letters to be made
patent, and the great seal of the State of Iowa to be here-
unto affixed, given under my hand at Des Moines,
the 23 day of June in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and sixty six, and of the
State of Iowa the nineteenth
