 Know all Men by these Presents:

That we, Anna L. Brown, Frank T. Brown, Carrie L. Holcomb, and Louis P. Brown, all of Polk County, Iowa, but temporarily residing elsewhere, do hereby make constitute and appoint Willis S. Brown of Polk County, Iowa, our true and lawful attorney with authority for us and in our place and stead and in our names, and for each and either of us, and in the name of each and either of us, to bargain, sell and convey by proper conveyances any or all of the real or personal property belonging to us or either of us in the State of Iowa; to appear for us or either of us in and to institute carry on and manage, all suits or other proceedings which he may deem it necessary or proper for us or either of us to institute or defend in the courts of Iowa, or elsewhere; to manage all property owned by us or either of us in the State of Iowa; to invest all monies of us or either of us; to collect and receipt for all amounts due us, or either of us; to borrow money in our names, or in the name of either of us, and to execute notes therefor, in our names or in the name of either of us, and to secure the same by collateral belonging to us or either of us, or by mortgage upon our property real or personal, or upon such property of either of us; and to do all acts and execute all contracts not above expressly mentioned which we or either of us might or could do or execute in connection with the management of the property of us or either of us in the State of Iowa.

Said attorney shall have the powers above enumerated as the attorney of each of us, and also as the attorney for all of us, giving and granting unto our said attorney full power and authority to do or perform everything necessary or proper to be done in or about the premises as fully as we or either of us might do it if personally present; and we hereby ratify and confirm all that our said attorney may do in the premises by virtue hereof.
