Madison County. I, William Erinson of said County and State, on oath depose and say that I am a son of Joseph Brinson and Rebecca Erinson; that Joseph Brinson was the husband of Rebecca Erinson, who on or about the 21st day of January, A.D. 1834, conveyed to Thomas Brinson the west one-half (1/2), of the East one-half (1/2), of the Northeast quarter (1/4), and the Northwest quarter (1/4), of the Northeast quarter (1/4), all in section eighteen (18), in township seventy five (75), north, range twenty eight (28) west of the fifth P.M., Iowa; said deed of conveyance being filed for record in the office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, on or about the 23rd day of January, A.D. 1834, and recorded in Deed Record "M" of said County, at page 714 thereof; and that said Joseph Brinson was the same person as the Joseph Brinson, who with his second wife Anna Brinson, executed to Rebecca Kiggins, a quit claim deed to the same real estate, on or about April 23rd, A.D. 1834, said deed of conveyance being filed for record in the office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, on or about the 10th day of May A.D. 1834, and recorded in Deed Record fourteen (14), of said County, at page 458 thereof; and that said Joseph Brinson and Rebecca Erinson were the same persons as the grantors in a deed executed to Tilman G. Harmon, on or about the 13th day of September, A.D. 1835, conveying the East one-half (1/2) of the East one-half (1/2), of the Northeast quarter (1/4) of said section, township, and range, which deed was filed for record in the office of the Recorder of Madison County, Iowa, on or about the 18th day of December, A.D. 1835, and recorded in Deed Record "O" of said County, at page 357 thereof; and that said grantors were husband and wife at that time. I also depose and say that said Tilman G. Harmon, grantee in said last mentioned deed, was the same person as the Tilman G. Harmon who with Lydia A. Harmon, then the wife of Tilman G. Harmon, conveyed unto Linvil M. Harmon, on or about the fifth day of July, A.D. 1837, a tract of land forty (40) rods by fifty six (56) rods, in the Southeast corner of said Northeast quarter (1/4) of said section, township, and range; said deed of conveyance being filed for record in the office of the recorder of Madison County, Iowa, on or about the 11th day of October, A.D. 1873, and recorded in Deed Record Seven (7) of said County, at page 632 thereof.
