I, William Brinson a resident of the State and County aforesaid, being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with the persons whose names are hereinafter mentioned, and am well and personally acquainted with the facts as herein set forth.

That Levi Shupe who together with his wife Mary Shupe on December 23<sup>rd</sup> 1887, conveyed 4 1/2 acres off the East end of the S.W. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of 15-75-28, by deed recorded in Deed Record "V" on page 112, as shown at entry No. 17 of abstract, is the same and identical person as the Levi Supe who together with N.H. James, on March 1<sup>st</sup> 1887 acquired title to the S.W. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of 15-75-28, by deed recorded in Deed Record "T" on page 237, as shown at entry No. 16 of abstract; his name having been spelled Levi Supe by mistake.

That John Bancroft and Elizabeth Bancroft were husband and wife on April 22<sup>nd</sup> 1883, at which time they conveyed to George Lane, the N.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of 23-75-28, except 1/2 acre out of the N.E. corner, by deed recorded in Deed Record "M" on page 523, and that the said John Bancroft is the same and identical person as the John Bancroft, to whom James Brinson and wife conveyed said land on February 26<sup>th</sup> 1858, by deed recorded in Deed Record "H" on page 325.

That John C. Culbertson and Mary Culbertson were husband and wife on March 15<sup>th</sup> 1854, at which time they conveyed to Lewis S. Carrett the NE 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of 14-75-28, by deed recorded in Deed Record "A" page 548.

That Lewis S. Carrett and Elsie I. Carrett were husband and wife on October 26<sup>th</sup> 1855, at which time they conveyed to Jared Jessup and Alvin Jessup the last above described land, by deed recorded in Deed Record "F" on page 110. That I am in no way interested in making the above statements other than to establish of record the facts as above set forth.
