Whereas the original plat of Pitzer & Knight's Addition to the town of Winterset, Iowa as recorded on page 147 of Record E of the Records of Madison County, Iowa, show an alley running East to West, and sixteen and one half feet (16½) in width was laid out through Block No. Twenty (20) of said Addition, and that the same was dedicated to the Public.

And whereas the said alley has been closed for more than ten years last past, and the public have had no highway through said Block No. Twenty (20) during the whole of said period of time

Now Know All Men by these Presents, That, I, E.E. McCall of the County of Madison and State of Iowa, the owner of all of said Block No. Twenty (20) of Pitzer & Knight's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, for the purpose of divesting all public rights in and to the real estate included within the alley as platted through said block and that the title thereto be vested in me, and that it become my property in fee, I do hereby declare that part of the said alley as platted through said block, vacated, as fully and completely as though no alley had ever been laid out, platted or dedicated through said Block.
